



Berean Academy offers preschool classes in Newton on the campus of Grace Community Church. The program is licensed by the state of Kansas and approved by the KDHE. Classes begin September and run through mid-May.

The purpose of our preschool program is to expose children and their families to excellent biblically integrated education at an affordable cost. Jesus called children to himself when he said, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not hinder them, for the Kingdom of God belongs to such as these." (Luke 18:6).

Berean Academy Preschool provides a happy, loving, challenging and distinctively Christian environment for your child. ### **Program and Fees**

At this time Berean offers both two-day and three-day morning classes. If these classes fill, additional classes may be added. Classes are formed per enrollment.

2-Day Program	\$110 per month
3-Day Program	\$150 per month
Re-enrollment Fee	\$ 50 per child(holds spot)
Morning Session:	9:00 - 11:30 a.m.
Afternoon Session:	1:00 - 3:30 p.m. (if needed)

*Extended care is not offered. Tuition is due even when a child is absent. Tuition and fees are paid monthly .*

## **Enrollment**

Enrollment will be limited to 9 students per class. Students will not be considered enrolled until each family has completed the preschool application, paid the \$50 enrollment fee and interview. For questions please contact the Admissions Director listed below at 316.799.2211.

## **Required Forms**

The following forms are to be on file prior to attending preschool in the fall:

- Preschool Application and Church Reference
- Current Health Assessment (including immunizations) signed by child's doctor
- Emergency Care Authorization, signed by parent

## **Dress Code**

Children attending Berean Academy Preschool should wear clothing appropriate for a learning environment. This includes pants, shorts, shirts, skirts and dresses. All clothing should be neat, modest, non-distracting and in good repair.

We will play outside whenever weather permits. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately and that all coats, hats, mittens, scarves and boots are marked with your child's name using a permanent marker.

## **K-12 Benefits**

All Berean Academy Preschool students will be given priority when enrolling in the K-12 program on the Elbing campus. Students enrolled in the program will be exposed to a fun and challenging Kindergarten readiness curriculum.
