



Full-time Custodian

The custodian will work under the direct supervision of the Maintenance Director to help maintain the excellent facilities the Lord has provided. This position will include all aspects of custodial work typical in school settings. This could be a part-time position or full-time year-round position. Work hours are somewhat flexible, but an individual able to work on school days from 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. would be preferred. For the full-time position, summer hours will be more flexible but likely from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Support campus administration, faculty, staff, and students.
- Clean classrooms, restrooms, and other spaces.
- Perform other custodial duties as required.
- Perform work according to prescribed procedures and operational schedule.
- Set up and tear down chairs, tables, and equipment for meetings.
- Perform painting and touch up painting if needed.
- Follow all applicable safety rules and procedures.
- Work in a manner that reflects the character of Jesus.

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Able to work well independently and as part of a team
- Must be punctual, reliable, and self-motivated
- Receive and follow oral and written orders from supervisor
- Ability to move consistently for up to eight hours per day
- Ability to operate standard custodial equipment if needed
- Superior customer-service and relational skills
- Ability to perform prolonged physical activity including standing, reaching, lifting to fifty pounds, handling, and fingering
- Develop a working knowledge of OSHA rules and regulations related to the handling of cleaning supplies and chemicals

- A committed Christian able to provide a written testimony of faith in Jesus Christ as Savior.
- Regular attendance at an evangelical church that upholds the Bible as holy, inspired by God, and inerrant.
- Agreement with the Berean Doctrinal Statement, Statement on Marriage, Gender, & Sexuality, and the Role Model Policy.
- Display a Christ-like attitude when relating to faculty, staff, parents, students, and others.
