



Maintenance Person

The maintenance person reports directly to the Maintenance Director. This position provides support for all aspects of the physical plant operations, including all buildings and grounds as assigned by the Maintenance Director, in order to maintain a safe, appealing space for all parents, students, faculty, staff, and visitors. Primary Responsibilities:

- Perform routine and preventative maintenance and upkeep on buildings and equipment to maximize the life and efficiency of all systems, including safe and secure electrical, plumbing, and HVAC systems.
- Repair school buildings and equipment as needed.
- Maintain the grounds, including mowing and other related duties.
- Oversees vehicle maintenance schedules.
- Perform custodial work as needed.

Personal Abilities & Qualifications:

- Demonstrable proficiency in general maintenance, light electrical, plumbing and HVAC repair, painting, and lock repair.
- Takes responsibility for the buildings and grounds – takes pride in their appearance.
- Able to work well as part of a team.
- Must be punctual and reliable.
- Ability to move consistently for up to eight hours per day.
- Skills to operate standard custodial equipment when needed.
- Ability to perform prolonged physical activity including standing, reaching, lifting to fifty pounds, handling, and fingering.
- Able to work independently and understand and carry out oral and written instructions.
- Background check clearance.
